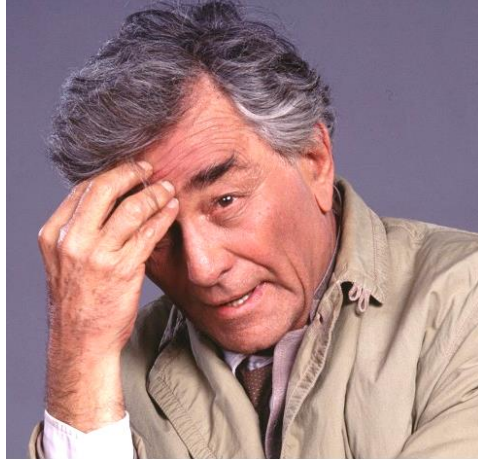
Thanksgiving Party by William H.

My best buddy Tim Smith says, "Jamie, I love this. It tastes so great." My other buddy is Marty. She is my only person who makes me smile.

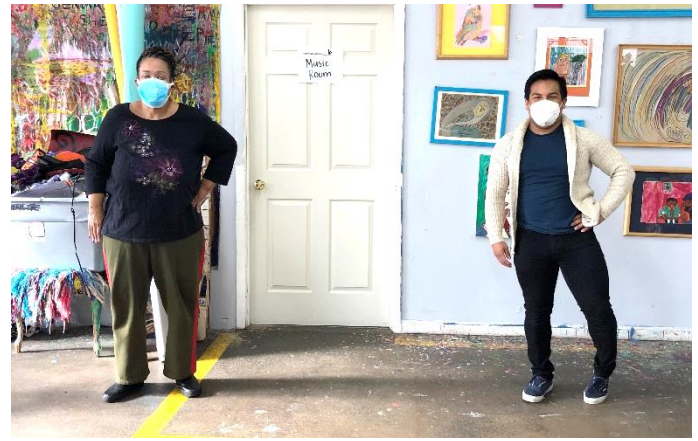
I am glad I be helping out with Jason in the kitchen. He is a good person how to learn the make a banana on a stick with hot chocolate or sprinkles.
